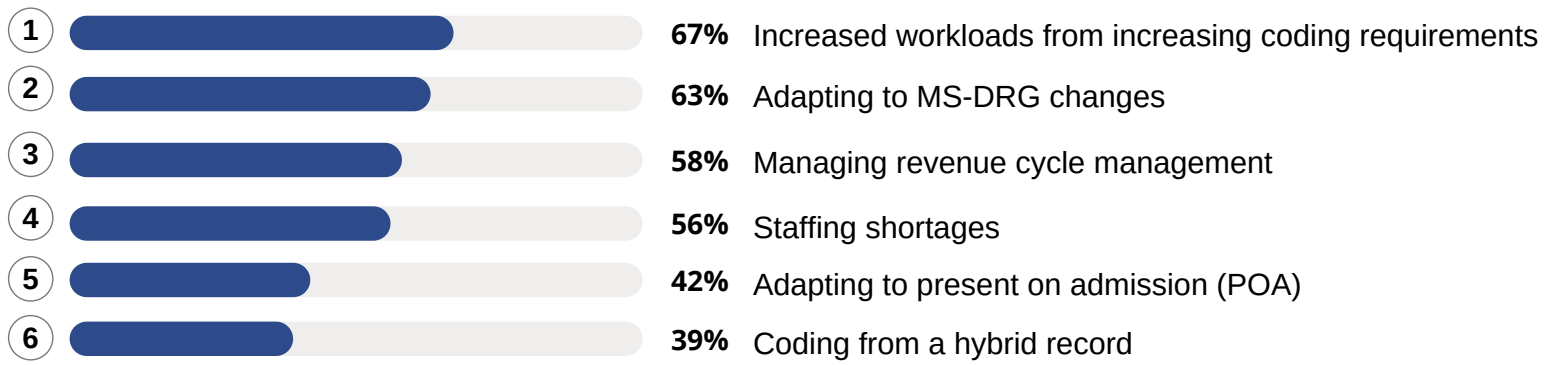

Hospitals nationwide still face a **30%** coder shortage<sup>2</sup>

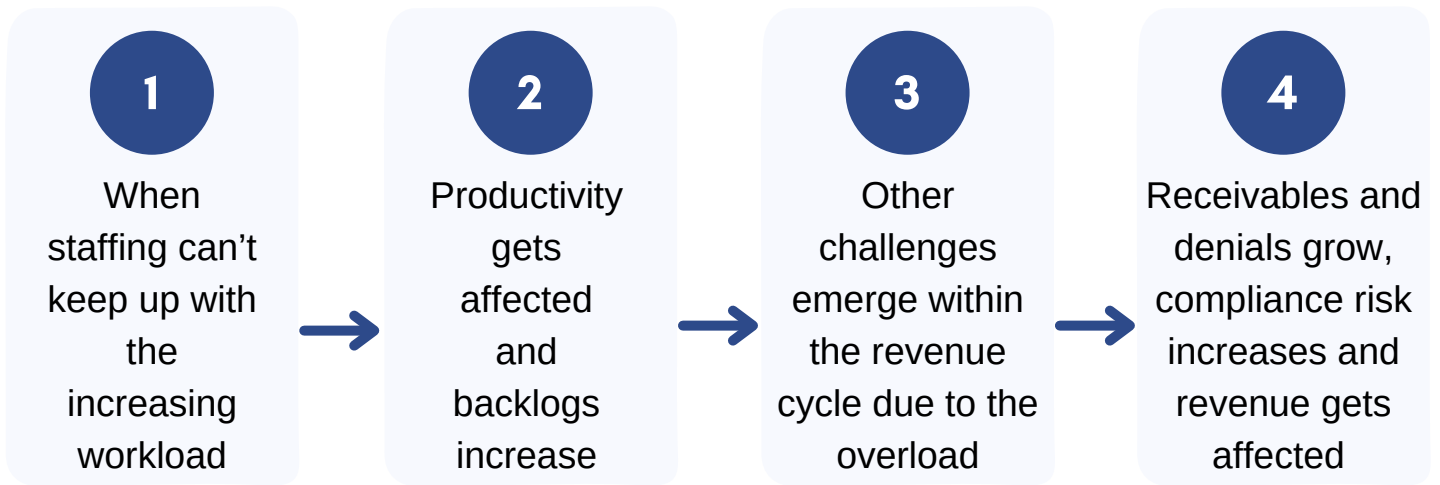


Medical coding is among the **20** fastest growing occupations<sup>3</sup>



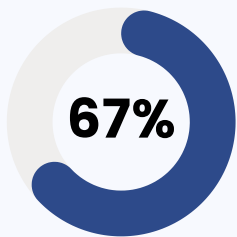
Medical coding jobs are projected to grow **15%** by 2024<sup>3</sup>

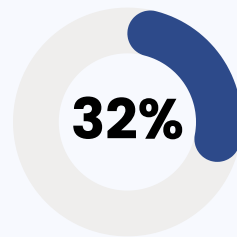


## DID YOU KNOW?
